Kurt Albertine, Ph. D. Professor: Department of Pediatrics, Department of Internal Medicine, University of Utah, School of Medicine, Editor- in-Chief, the Anatomical Records A and B

Kurt H. Albertine, Ph.D., is Professor of Pediatrics (Neonatology), as well as Adjunct Professor of Medicine (Pulmonary) and Neurobiology & Anatomy at the University of Utah, School of Medicine in Salt Lake City, UT, USA. His research, focused on acute and chronic lung disease, with emphasis on neonatal chronic lung disease, has been supported by NIH grants for 30 years. Dr. Albertine is author of over 150 publications, including 4 textbooks. He is a permanent member of the Lung Injury, Repair and Remodeling Study Section at NHLBI. He has served as a reviewer, member of the editorial board, and editor for over 30 journals, and is currently Editor-in-Chief of The Anatomical Record. He has organized and led approximately 20 courses on scientific writing, has participated in about 20 publishing, grant writing, and mentoring workshops, and regularly speaks on career development issues for scientists at national and international venues.



Gary C. Schoenwolf, Ph.D. Distinguished Professor, Department of Neurobiology and Anatomy, Adjunct Professor, Department of Pediatrics, University of Utah School of Medicine, Editor-in-Chief, Developmental Dynamics.

Gary C. Schoenwolf, Ph.D., is the founder of the Children's Health Research Center at the University of Utah, a training center for physician-scientists, which he directed for almost a decade. His research program, currently focused on molecular patterning of the developing inner ear, has been continuously funded by the National Institutes of Health for over 30 years, and he is the author of over 200 publications, including more than 10 textbooks. He has served as a reviewer, member of the editorial board, and editor for over 50 journals, and is currently Editor-in-Chief of Developmental Dynamics. He has organized and led approximately 20 publishing, grant writing, and mentoring workshops, and regularly speaks on career development issues for scientists at national and international venues.
